

Joseph Kabwe Named to USL-1 Team of the Week

— Carolina RailHawks midfielder Joseph Kabwe was named to the USL-1 Team of the Week, the USL announced Tuesday.

Kabwe's performance against Puerto Rico last Saturday night was nothing short of spectacular as he recorded an assist and created havoc for the Puerto Rico defense.
